CLASS RULES

- 1. Be respectful of:
 - your teacher (including substitute teachers)

CLASS PROCEDURES

- 1. Be on time for class. Take your seat and be prepared to learn before the bell. Repeated tardies will result in extra "bonding" time during 9th period.

- 8. Cell phones: These are a hand-held computers, see computer policies on back. Strike 1=warning, Strike 2=phone on my desk until 3:20pm and no music/youtube for the rest of the year, Strike 3=phone sent to the office.
- 9. Grading will be based on the use of rubrics, quizzes, and your observed effort in class.
- 10. Assignments should be handed in on their due date.
 - $\circ\quad$ Any late assignment loses 2 points per day that it is late.
 - o Make arrangements to come in to make up work.
 - o Assignments will not be accepted after a 5 week mark. No exceptions.

SAFETY RULES IN THE LAB

LISTENING, PAYING ATTENTION, & ASKING QUESTIONS are just some of the ways of making sure that the time spent in this lab is injury free and enjoyable.

Fire Safety: When the fire alarm sounds, remain quiet, turn off machine in use and exit the building according to the exit plan without talking.

Personal Safety in the Lab. Following are lab considerations:

- 1. Absolutely NO horseplay in the lab. You will lose your lab privileges.
- 2. Machine use: You must have a lesson/demonstration and permission before using any machine in this lab. Follow specific safety rules for each machine. Think through the entire operation before actually doing it (measure twice, cut once!).
- 3. Safety glasses must be worn while working with any tool!
- 4. No gathering around a machine in use and no distracting of or talking to the operator.
- 5. The machine operator is the only one that may turn a machine on and off.
- 6. Any injury of any kind must be reported to O'Malley.
- 7. Work safely by working slowly and carefully.
- 8. Report dull, broken or damaged tools to O'Malley immediately.
- 9. Clean as you go!
- 10. If you have doubts or questions, ASK FOR HELP!!

Computer Use:

- 1. Be familiar with the school's computer use policy: It is the law of the land!
- 2. Think before you search!!! Keep your internet research focused.
- 3. Computers/Chromebooks/Cellphones are to be used for purposes explained in class only. Strike 1=warning, Strike 2=no music/youtube for the rest of the year
- 4. Homework for other classes may not be worked on during class time.
- 5. File Management: Keep all files organized in a CDE folder in your H:drive & Google Drive
- 6. Do not forget to log off of any computer in the lab when you are done.
