- → Tests and quizzes CANNOT be retaken
- → Test corrections are REQUIRED
 - ◆ Count as separate a 20 point assignment No extra points will be added to the actual test based on corrections
 - ◆ If you do not do test corrections, you will be mandated to stay 9th period to complete the corrections and will receive a 0

Absences:

- → It is your responsibility to retrieve your notes from the absent binder
