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Letter from Our Superintendent

Dear Akron School Community,

Over the course of this past school year, our district has engaged in a comprehensive and collaborative process to chart the future of Akron Central Schools. Thanks to the participation and thoughtful input of students, staff, families, and community members, we are now ready to share the results of this work—our 2025-2028 Strategic Plan, which will guide our district for the next three years.

Partnering with Erie 1 BOCES to support this work, we began last fall by engaging the community through a Thought Exchange Interview Survey. This unique survey format, enhanced by artificial intelligence, allowed us to gather candid, in-depth feedback on what is working well in our district and where we can grow. We also checked in on key areas of our previous plan—communication, inclusivity, and personalized learning—while ensuring each stakeholder group's voice was distinctly heard.

Following the survey, we hosted focus groups and formed a Strategic Planning Committee comprised of diverse representatives from our school community. This committee met throughout this past school year to examine feedback, identify priorities, and build concrete action steps to guide our work.

We are excited to share the new Akron Central Schools Strategic Plan for 2025–2028 and hope you will notice that our new goals are a logical progression from those outlined in our previous Strategic Plan. We are proud of the work we've done in these areas and continue to value and prioritize the work of ensuring every Akron student thrives - academically, socially, and as a valued member of our community.

Looking forward, we will launch new committees focused on Community Partnerships, Student Belonging, and Academic Innovation, and continue to gather input as we implement these goals.
