Please read the following procedures carefully:

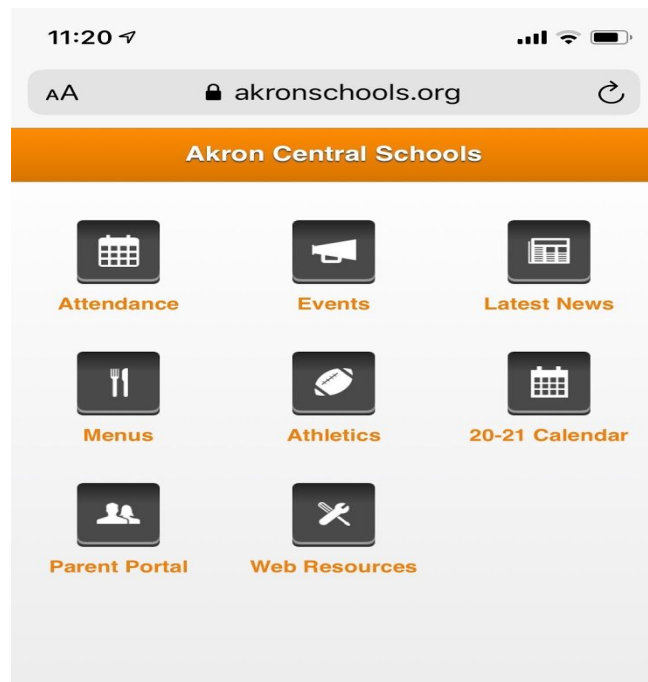
- **All remote students, either fully remote or hybrid students on their “at home” remote learning days, will complete this form daily no later than 9:00 AM.**
- This form is for all students K-12. Parents may need to assist students in completing this form.
- The form can be found on the front page of the District webpage at www.akronschools.org. We have included some pictures to assist you.
- Social-emotional support is a major emphasis of our District. Included on the form is a daily check in for students to share how they are feeling that day. We will carefully examine these responses and reach out to students who may be struggling to support them in any way we can.
- If you do not have access to the internet or can not complete the form for any reason, please call the school office to confirm your child’s attendance.
