## **The Application Process**

(in brief)

- 1. Complete Applications (September-November of senior year)
  - a. The Common Application (commonapp.org)
  - b. SUNY Application (suny.edu/applysuny/)
  - c. Through the college's website
  - d. Erie Community College, Niagara Count Community College, Genesee Community College instant admission days at ACS
- 2. Ask Teachers for letters of recommendation (September/October of senior year)
  - a. You will ask for as many copies as the number of schools you are applying to
  - b. If you apply through the Common Application be sure to talk with teachers before electronically "inviting" them to recommend you.
  - c. Mailing these letters is the student's responsibility. You will mail these to the Office of Admissions at the college. Their addresses are found on their websites
- 3. Let Mrs. Tiedt in Student Support know that you have applied
  - a. If you apply through the Common Application or SUNY Application, your counselor will receive an email requesting your transcript
  - b. If you apply through a college's website, you must let Mrs. Tiedt know in order for your transcript to be sent
- 4. Let Mrs. Tiedt know when you have been accepted somewhere!
- 5. Complete Financial Aid (October of senior year)
  - a. Complete your FAFSA (Financial Aid) at FAFSA.ed.gov
  - b. This can be completed as early as October 1st of your senior year

- 6. Applying for Scholarships (Summer entering senior year, throughout senior year)
