

## GRADING Policy

Homewoork: All homework will be out of 5 points (5 points for complete, 3 points for incomplete or late, 0 if not in class or not done)

*Tests*: Tests count twice in the gradebook, each out of 100 points. The first test grade is the students original score and the second grade is the students score if test corrections are provided by the teacher. If test corrections are provided and the student chooses to complete them, they must be perfect to receive 5 points back on the second test grade. If a student does not do test corrections or corrections are not offered, the second test grade will be the same as the first. Students can submit test corrections until they are perfect. Corrections will be accepted until the day of the next test.
