Student Supplies & Procedures (2025-2026)

Below you will find a listing of supply requirements and procedures for Middle School Students in grade 6 for the 2025-2026 school year. This information should alleviate some parental and student questions about school procedures; it should also aid parents as they work with their child(ren) during the school year.

GENERAL SUPPLIES
