**Student Supplies & Procedures (2022-2023)**

Below you will find a listing of supply requirements and procedures for Middle School Students in grade 6 for the 2022-2023 school year. This information should alleviate some parental and student questions about school procedures; it should also aid parents as they work with their child(ren) during the school year.

**General Supplies:**

Each student is expected to keep a supply pouch of pencils, pens, highlighters, colored pencils and the appropriate calculator in the supply pouch at all times. Students must bring the supply pouch to every class and replenish supplies as needed.
