SAFETY MEASURES

- All students and staff will continue to wear masks at all times, except for during mask breaks
- Continued use of desk barriers
- 3 ft. social distancing at all times in classrooms
- 6 ft. social distancing in areas where students are eating, engaging in aerobic activities, singing, or playing a musical instrument
 - 6 ft. markings and traffic patterns marked in all hallways.
- Continued use of temperature checks for all students and staff
- Hand sanitizer in all classrooms and regular hand washing built in to daily schedule





Arrival

Arrival:

- Students coming on the bus will report directly to their classroom unless they eat breakfast. If students coming in on the bus eat breakfast, they can go directly to the MPR to eat their bagged breakfast and eat there.
- Students being dropped off between 7:30-8:00 will be guided to the gymnasium. If students being dropped off eat breakfast, they will go directly to the cafeteria to eat.
- Temperature checks upon arrival at drop off door as well as on the bus.

Drop Off/Pick Up:

- There will be additional information forthcoming regarding the logistics of Drop off and Pick Up. All current traffic patterns will remain the same.





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Breakfast and Lunch

Breakfast and Lunch:

- Breakfast and lunch will continue to be free for all students for the duration of this school year.
- Students will eat in both the MPR and Cafeteria.
- Students will be distanced 6 ft. apart from each other at cafeteria tables with shields where allowable.





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Non-classroom Environments

Lockers:

- Continue to utilize lockers by cohorts for Elementary
- Staggered by a schedule

Hallways

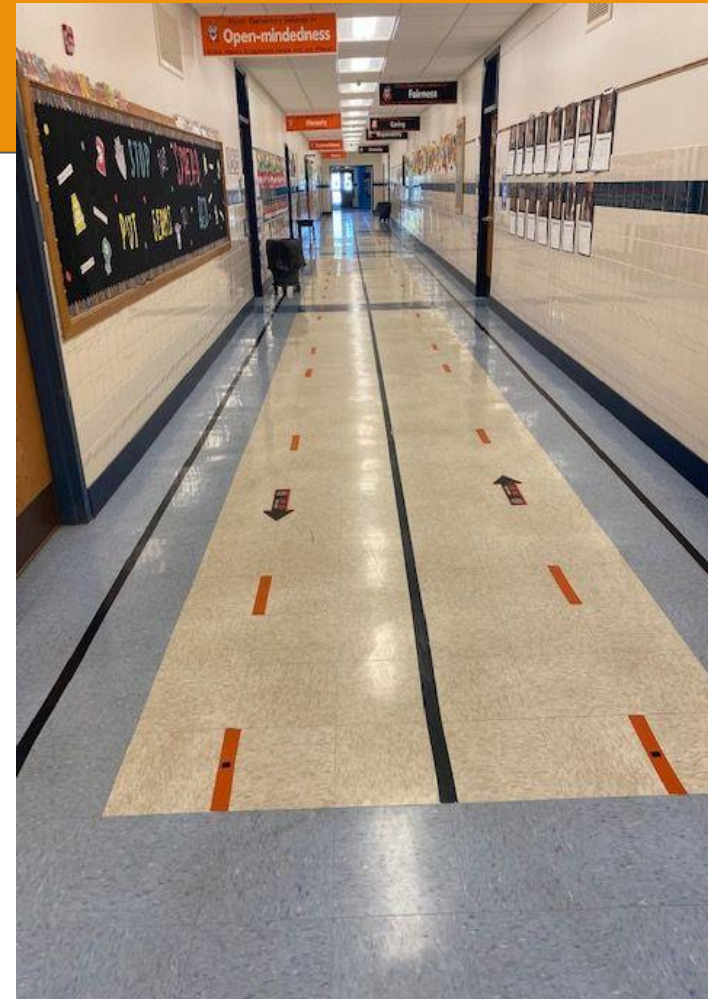
- Continue with one way traffic patterns

Elementary Playgrounds:

- Classes will continue to follow our set playground schedule allowing only one class at a time

Elementary Gymnasium:

- Continued use upon arrival and dismissal
- Will be used for PE classes (one class at a time)





Quarantine Guidelines

- Current quarantine guidelines adhere to 6 ft. of social distancing and our students will be seated at 3 ft. Therefore if a student in a classroom tests positive, the entire class will be quarantined for 10 days.
- As long as students are not ill, they will be asked to work remotely to engage in their coursework.
- If the teacher is vaccinated, they are not required to quarantine (according to CDC and ECDOH guidance), which would allow them to work within the building even if class is quarantined.





Remote Teaching and Learning

- Fully remote students will continue to engage in learning with their current remote teacher. Some adjustments to learning model may be made and will be communicated with remote student parents.
 - Fully remote students must complete remote attendance form every day.
- All students will continue to be fully remote on Wednesdays.
 - All students must complete remote attendance form on Wednesdays
