





Akron Central School District OACM Meeting Minutes 2023 Capital Improvement Project April 24, 2025

1. Construction Update

- A. Transportation Facility Addition
 - The General Trades Contractor is complete with structural steel work, and cold-formed metal framing is in progress.
 - Roofing substrate board and vapor barrier are being installed by the General Trades Contractor. The Plumbing Contractor installed new roof drains.
 - In the Bus Wash Bay, the Plumbing Contractor finished underground sanitary piping and set new trench drains. The Mechanical Contractor installed gridded insulation, radiant tubing, and roughed in sensors for the in-slab heating system.
 - The General Trades Contractor started prep and rebar for interior concrete slabs. Concrete pours for slabs are scheduled to begin the week of 4/28.
- B. <u>K-12 Educational Building</u>
 - Pool wall tile, expansion joints, and new ADA lift were completed by the General Trades Contractor over April Break.
 - The General Trades Contractor completed flooring abatement in the Elementary School Bathrooms over April Break.

2. Contracts Procurement

- A. Contract 109: Signage (Takeform)
 - The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS)
 - Updated proposal of \$95,846 received.
 - Value increased from preliminary proposal due to added and enhanced scopes.
 - District stated the "A" logo does not need to be revised.
 - District requested some extra images for the History Walls to rotate through. Takeform to add these to their proposal.
 - District's committee needs to review and approve the final design package.
 - Targeting the 5/13 BOE Meeting for contract award.
- B. Phase II Contracts
 - Traditionally Bid Awarded by BOE on 4/10, inclusive of all Alternates.
 - Contract 200: Site Work Northeast Diversification
 - Contract 201: General Trades NCI Construction

 - Contract 205: Track Surfacing

3. Project Budget Summary

- A. Incidental Budget FF&E
 - District will purchase furnishings directly without the use of a vendor.
 - The District is working with HON for the Bus Garage Addition office furniture. CPL provided room layouts to aid in furniture selections.
 - There is some loose furniture needed for High School H-Wing areas.
 - A vendor will likely be needed for this furniture. CPL will get their interior design team involved.
- B. Project Budget Summary dated 4/23/25 attached.
 - Unallocated Construction Dollars = \$1,371,625
 - Phase II bid values came in lower than the allocated budget.

4. General Items / New Business

- A. Discuss potential scopes of work to be incorporated into the Project using the Unallocated Construction Dollars.
 - Reference the Unawarded Alternates attachment. The attachment is updated based on conversations in the meeting.
 - Phase I Unawarded Alternates
 - CCMG will speak to Contractors to see if they will hold their bid day pricing for the Middle School Window Shades and Bus Garage Snow Melt System Zones #3 and #4.
 - Phase II VE Items
 - Intent would be to integrate scope enhancements / additions into the current design.
 - CPL to bring old renderings and conceptual designs to the next OACM Meeting for team discussion for the following areas:
 - Phase I Furniture in HS H-Wing

 - Phase II Area of Reflection
 - Phase II Site Work VE Drawing (reduced hardscape areas)
