THIS MONTH

June will consist of reviewing for the Regents Exam. In May, students took a practice Regents Exam and were given a Regents "score." Using this information, students should take it upon themselves to continue to study at home.

There are MANY old exams that I have available for students in the classroom to take home and work on (or complete with me during study halls/9th periods). If students complete them, I will grade them and give them a practice score.

Students should be studying nightly! Please encourage your child to review, even for a few minutes each night! I would recommend completing practice exams or redoing questions that they missed on exams we have completed in-class or during Regents Review.

REGENTS EXAM

The Algebra 1 Regents Exam is Wednesday, June 18th at 12pm. There are no make-ups; if students miss the exam, they must wait and take the exam when it is administered again in August. Passing the Algebra Regents Exam is a graduation requirement.

ADDITIONAL REVIEW

Additional review will be offered Monday, 6/16 after the ELA 9 Exam or Wednesday, 6/18 before the Algebra Exam. Students are welcome to just come up to my room during this time.
