Dear Akron Parents and Families,

Our district has established plans for returning Chromebooks, textbooks, library books, uniforms and any other learning resources checked out from the school. Musical instruments should be returned only if you are not continuing with the instrument or if you are a senior. Chromebooks should be returned in their cases. Only grades K, 1, 2, 4, 8 and 12 need to return their power supply cords. All other grades levels can keep the power cords for the next school year. Each building has outlined their plans in the descriptions below.

Elementary Procedure

On **Tuesday, June 16th**, all Chromebooks, library books, and other classroom learning resources should be returned to the district.

Please adhere, if possible, to the specific times indicated below in order to avoid congestion. However, if you have children that are in multiple grades, please come at a time that best fits your needs within these time frames.

- Kindergarten - 9:00 - 10:00 AM
- First Grade - 10:00 - 11:00 AM
- Second Grade - 11:00 - 12:00 AM
- Third Grade - 12:30 - 1:30 PM
- Fourth Grade - 1:30 - 2:30 PM
- Fifth Grade - 2:30 - 3:30 PM
- If you cannot come during any of the times listed above, there will be an additional drop off window from 3:30 - 5:00 PM.

To adhere to all recent safety recommendations, we have arranged the drop off so you do not need to get out of your car.

Where?

Elementary Side Lot

Parents will enter the Akron Elementary Lot Entrance from Bloomingdale Avenue. Parents will pull forward staying to the right side nearest the curb. Please move forward as spaces are available. Pull forward as far as possible.

Drop-Off Procedure:

As parents or family members pull forward, please have your child's name written on a paper with items being returned.

Middle School Procedure

When?

On **Wednesday, June 17th**, all Chromebooks, library books, textbooks, uniforms, and other learning resources should be returned to the district.

Please adhere, if possible, to the specific times indicated below in order to avoid congestion. However, if you have children that are in multiple grades, please come at a time that best fits your needs within these time frames.

- Sixth Grade - 9:00 - 11:00 AM
- Seventh Grade - 11:00 - 1:00 PM
- Eighth Grade - 1:30 - 3:30 PM
- If you cannot come during any of the times listed above, there will be an additional drop off window from 3:30 - 5:00 PM.

Where?

Elementary Side Lot

Parents will enter the Akron Elementary Lot Entrance from Bloomingdale Avenue. Parents will pull forward staying to the right side nearest the curb. Please move forward as spaces are available. Pull forward as far as possible.

Drop-Off Procedure:

As parents or family members pull forward, please have your child's name written on a paper with items being returned.

High School Procedure

When?

On **Thursday, June 18th**, all Chromebooks, library books, textbooks, calculators, uniforms and other learning resources should be returned to the district. Select Advanced Placement (AP) Courses will have summer work so there will be a Chromebook pick up at the end of July for those students.

Please adhere, if possible, to the specific times indicated below in order to avoid congestion. However, if you have children that are in multiple grades, please come at a time that best fits your needs within these time frames.

- Seniors - 8:00 - 10:00 AM
- Juniors - 10:00 - 12:00 PM
- Sophomores - 12:30 - 2:30 PM
- Freshman - 2:30 - 4:30 PM
- If you cannot come during any of the times listed above, there will be an additional drop off window from 4:30 - 5:00 PM.

To adhere to all recent safety recommendations, we have arranged the drop off so you do not need to get out of your car.

Where?

Elementary Side Lot

Parents will enter the Akron Elementary Lot Entrance from Bloomingdale Avenue. Parents will pull forward staying to the right side nearest the curb. Please move forward as spaces are available. Pull forward as far as possible.
