### Quizzes:

- → Given around the half-way point of longer chapters
- → Worth 100 points
- → No corrections completed on quizzes

#### Tests:

- → Given at the end of each chapter
- → Worth 200 points
- → Test corrections are REQUIRED
  - ◆ Count as a separate 20 point assignment
  - No extra points will be added to tests based on corrections
  - ◆ If you do not do test corrections, you will be mandated to stay 9th period to complete the corrections without credit

#### Absences:

- → If you are absent on the day homework is due, that assignment is due at the beginning of class the day that you return
- → HW assigned the day you were absent is due within 1 day of the absence.
- → It is your responsibility to retrieve your notes and homework assignment from the absent bin and submit them on-time
- → A test or quiz missed during absence will be taken on the day of return, unless corresponding subject matter was also missed
- → If you know beforehand that you will miss class, see me to get assignments and missed work ahead of time

#### Miscellaneous:

- → <u>Mandatory 9th Period</u>: Students failing at any of the ten-week marks will be required to stay 9th period at least one day per week.
